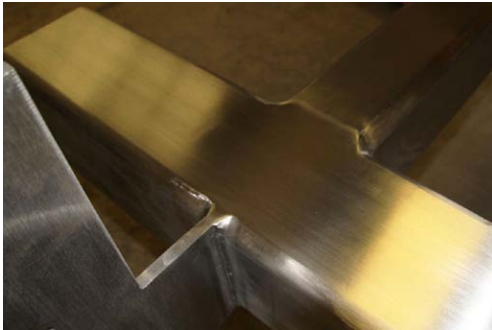

ADDITIONAL DETAILS
